The Regular Meeting of the Deerfield Village Council was called to order by President Todd Nighswander at 7:00 p.m.

Guests Present: Brad Heineman from the Advance, Julius Brown, Robert Knoblauch candidate for County Commissioner District 7, Brett Holubik Fire Chief.

Minutes of the Regular meeting were read & approved.

Motion: Sieler to approve the Treasurer's Report -2nd: Eggleston Carried. Motion: Nighswander to include treasurers report on website -2nd: Gilson Carried.

Planning Commission— Planning Commission met prior to Council meeting. Feb. & May minutes submitted and reviewed by Council. They will be making efforts to fill open position and will be contacting Region II for assistance with park ordinance.

Report – Trustee Bocskay gave itemized recommendations to Council and they will review recommendations. Motion Holubik to purchase a locking filing cabinet 2nd Nighswander – Carried. BD art teacher was contacted and she will follow up with Council in Sept. or Oct. Estimate for the tree by 359 Carey St. was obtained. Clerk will find out cost to just have it topped. Estimates will be obtained to do driveway repair for Diver & Langmeyer.

New Business: Overtime for July reviewed. Water Committee will meet to review water bills. Options to fill swimming pools – garden hose, hiring outside water hauling company or call Village Employee who will use fire hydrants. Motion Sieler to update pool fill form and use for residents who have their pool filled by a Village Employee -2nd Nighswander Yaes 6 - Nays 1 Carried. Residents with concerns about the Village should present them to the Village Council at the scheduled meeting to remain in compliance with the Open Meeting Act rather than emailing concerns. Property on Raisin St. —Clerk will give owner's contact information to Bldg. Insp to get final on building permit.

Guests: Robert Knoblauch candidate for County Commissioner District 7. Sees the challenges that are being faced but feels his experience in Twp & County government will aid him in serving the District well and asked for support at the Nov. election. If elected he will step down as Assessor.

Julius Brown – served on the Council in the past and was interested in the current operations of the Council.

Closed general meeting at 8:10 to go into executive session to review status of resume's.

Adjourned Executive session at 8:50 and continued open meeting. Motion Nighswander to make a verbal offer to prospective employee within 48 hrs 2nd Sieler – Carried.

Motion Holubik to hire short term relief for DPW pending discussion with employees - 2nd Eggleston Carried.
